Manfred B. Steger is professor of Global Studies and Director of the Globalism Research Centre at RMIT University. He is also program leader of “Globalization and Culture,” in the Global Cities Institute at RMIT University. In addition, he is senior research fellow at the Globalization Research Center in Honolulu, Hawaii, and an affiliated graduate faculty member with the Department of Political Science at the University of Hawaii-Manoa. He has delivered many lectures on globalization, ideology, and non-violence in the Americas, Asia, Europe, the Middle East, Africa, and Australia. Comprised of 16 books, dozens of articles and book chapters, and numerous reviews, professor Steger’s academic work has been cited widely in the pertinent literature. His study “*Globalism: The New Market Ideology*” (Rowman & Littlefield, 2002), won the 2003 Michael Harrington Award of the New Political Science Section of the American Political Science Association. He has been a consultant on globalization for the U.S. State Department and an advisor on a U.S. Public Television series on the rise and fall of Socialism.
