

Master of Social Work / Master of Public Administration Concurrent Degrees Program Sample Course Plan

Students select **one** of the sample schedules below depending on whether you plan to take the MSW courses in the two-year or three-year model. Each student decides how to fit in the remaining required MPA courses (listed at the end of this document). MPA courses are offered each semester and some are offered in summer. Students may take MPA courses each semester or selected semesters or wait to complete the additional MPA coursework in subsequent semesters beyond the 2 or 3 MSW year plans. It is up to the student to determine the workload that suits them.
